Seeking Urgent Inputs on inclusion of Advanced Technologies in Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Automotive

As you are aware, the Government of India has recently announced the Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for Automobile and Auto Components Sector.

The scheme with a budgetary outlay of Rs 26,000 crores is aimed at attracting investments in segments of the automotive value-chain that are non-existent or are weak in India. That apart, the scheme is designed to overcome the cost disabilities for manufacturing of Advanced Automotive Technology products and systems in India.

In this context, the Ministry of Heavy Industries has asked ACMA to compile a list of Advanced Technology components – systems and sub-systems, that can be considered for incentives under the PLI.

Should you have any recommendation on any component for being considered for incentive under the PLI, then do please positively send your inputs in the prescribed format to the **ACMA secretariat** at sushil.rajput@acma.in by **28th September 2021**. Do please ensure that all necessary information, as sought by the government, is duly provided, without which your recommendation is likely to be rejected.
