ACMA – Northern Region is pleased to bring it to its members the much-awaited Annual Regional QC Competition, scheduled for **Friday**, **30**th **July 2021**.

ACMA Member companies or plants who are located in Northern Region can participate in this competition. Northern Region Consists of Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab (including Chandigarh), Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh.

In view of safety of the participants and to avoid the infection and spread of Covid-19, this year's QC competition too, is being organised "<u>Online</u>" by ACMA, just like last year.

ACMA's QC Competition over the years has become a much-awaited event giving fair chance to all members including the SSI companies to share and showcase efforts being taken for problem solving and promoting QC as a culture.

The Jury, as in the past would be invited from the OE circles.

We are also pleased to inform you that the **National QC Competition**, this year would be **hosted by the Western Region**, on 20th **August 2021**, again an online version.

The online competition platform will enable more number of teams to participate, as it eliminates the need for travel.

Being the Online edition of the Competition, there are few changes, as under:

- > The competition would be organized in a Digital platform (Cisco WebEx).
- Presentation Time slots would be assigned to each team for participation that would be communicated one day prior to the event, to the participating teams.
- Winners would be announced in an online Valedictory Session on the Friday, 30th July 2021.
- > Jury's decision would be final and cannot be challenged.

- Participation Certificates for competing teams would be couriered to companies post the event upon receiving full payment towards participation fees.
- Regional Winners Trophy would be handed over to the team through the Company's Management.

To ensure an inclusive growth, a level playing field at the competition has been provided to members from the Small Sector to actively participate and promote QC activities. SSI members stand to gain a lot by competing in the QC Competition as they would be able to show-case what steps they have taken to enhance quality and employee involvement and at the same time would also be able to witness presentations of other companies both SSI and Large & Medium companies. Experts views and suggestions from the Panel of Jury Member will be an added advantage to carry it forward.

We, hereby, invite members to participate actively by sending-in their teams to participate at this event.

Please note that First Three Position Winners from the Regional Competition would be eligible to participate at the National level QC Competition, as always.

Please follow the <u>Guidelines</u> enclosed while nominating teams.

Guidelines: As a Team

- ACMA Member companies or plants who are located in Northern Region can participate in this competition. Northern Region Consists of Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab (including Chandigarh), Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh.
- Companies are requested to fill the Reply Form along with a One-page QC Synopsis latest by Friday, 2nd July 2021.
- Teams would have to adhere to and make presentations online as per the given Guidelines.
- Companies have to ensure good internet connectivity on the date of the event for smooth functioning of the competition.
- The Team would have to install the required application on 2 laptops and share the screen for making their presentation, with their camera option on.
- <u>The Team would have to necessarily log-in with their Team Name & Company Name only</u>.
- A QC team cannot have more than 6 members (1 Facilitator + 5 members).
- Please note Teams with Workmen/Women Associates and Diploma Holders qualify to compete at the competition. There will be different assessments for Diploma holders & Workmen/women Associates.
- Companies with dues to ACMA like Membership Subscription for 2020-21, 2021-22 should have cleared all their dues to become eligible for participation at the QC Competition.

In order to motivate the teams further and encourage more participation from the membership, we added more awards since last few years. Accordingly there will be 6 Awards categories as stated below:

- a) Overall Best 3 nos. who wins the First 3 positions of the QC Competition, separately for SSI as well if we receive enough participation from SSI companies.
- b) Best 3 Presentations under each category of Cost Reduction, Facility Improvement, Productivity Improvement, Safety & Customer Complaints, depending on the number of entries received under each Category.

Registration Details of Quality Circle Competition (For Members Only)

For Q C Circle Team

- Member Companies in Northern Region or member companies whose plants are located in Northern Region will be eligible to participate in this competition from their NR based Plants.
- Rs. 3,000/- + taxes as per govt. rules, per team for a SSI members (total 6 members including Team Leader/Facilitator)
- Rs. 5,000/- + taxes as per govt. rules, per team for Medium & Large members (total 6 members including Team Leader/Facilitator)
- Companies with no dues to ACMA towards its Membership Subscription for 2020-21 & 2021-22 will only be eligible to participate.
- Please follow the Guidelines enclosed while nominating teams.

- Teams with Diploma Holders / Engineers will be evaluated upon a higher level of tools application & knowledge and will have a different weightage criteria as decided by the Jury including problem selection, Observations, analysis, action, savings, checks, standardization etc. This is to ensure a level playing field for a healthy competition.
- A QC team should not have more than 6 members (1 Facilitator + 5 members).

For Participation as Delegates: Rs. 590/- (Including GST) per delegate will be charged.
