Continuing with our efforts to enhance and engage our Industries personnel with the intent for a cross-learning platform. ACMA NR is pleased to inform you that after a gap of two years and normally gradually returning to business post pandemic, we hereby delighted to announce the 19th edition of the Annual Regional Quality Circle Competition of ACMA Northern Region, to be conducted In-Person on **Friday**, 29th July 2022 at ACMA Centre of Excellence (ACoE) at Saksham, IIT Delhi Technopark, Near Khewra, Sonipat (Haryana).

To ensure an inclusive growth, a level playing field at the competition has been provided to members from the SSI Sector to actively participate and promote QC activities i.e. a separate stream at the competition for SSI members to compete amongst each other. However, this would depend on the number of entries from the SSI member companies.

In order to motivate the teams further and encourage more participation from the membership, we added more awards since last two years. Accordingly there will be 7 Awards as stated below:

- a) Overall Best 3 nos. who wins the First 3 positions of the QC Competition, separately for SSI as well if we receive enough participation from SSI companies.
- b) Best 3 Presentations under each category of Cost reduction, Facility Improvement, Productivity Improvement, Safety & Customer Complaints.

The Winner(s) of the National Competition would be awarded at the **Annual Session of ACMA** on **September, 2022** in New Delhi.

- To improve the bottom-line by improving Quality, Productivity, Cost Reduction, Safety.
- To promote QC Movement within the Organization in a systematic manner.
- To improve communication and develop leadership

The broad Program of the day will be:

- QC Teams Presentation for the Competition by Individual teams of member companies
- Best Quality Circle teams will be decided by the team of Jury members and awarded with a Regional winners trophy and a Certificate at the Valedictory Session on the same day.

Registration Details of Quality Circle Competition (For Members Only)

For Q C Circle Team

- Member Companies with plants in Northern Region only.
- Rs 8,000 +18% GST = Rs 9440/- only per team for a SSI members (total 6 members including Team Leader/Facilitator)
- Rs 17,000 + 18% GST = Rs 20,060/- only per team for Medium & Large member (total 6 members including Team Leader/Facilitator)
- Companies with no dues to ACMA like Events outstanding, Membership Subscription for 2021–22 & 2022-23 will only be eligible to participate.
- Please follow the Guidelines enclosed while nominating teams.

- Teams with Diploma Holders / Engineers will be evaluated upon a higher level of tools application & knowledge and will have a different weightage criteria as decided by the Jury including problem selection, Observations, analysis, action, savings, checks, standardization etc. This is to ensure a level playing field for a healthy competition.
- A QC team should not have more than 6 members (1 Facilitator + 5 members). Additional members (more than 6 nos.) in the team will be considered as Additional Delegates and the participation fee of Delegates will be charged.

For Participation as Delegates: Rs. 3,000 + 18% GST = Rs. 3540/- only, per delegate will be charged.
