The Six Sigma Certification Program has been receiving an excellent response from the ACMA Members, and Northern Region has successfully completed its 19 Batches, so far.

Till date, ACMA has conducted 42 batches of the Black Belt program in various regions, out of which 19 batches are completed in North.

In the Northern Region alone, we have created 323 Six Sigma Black Belt personnel out of 576 overall. The Black Belts in Northern Region are doing well and have saved Rs.223 millions for their companies, put together. (as per the feedback given by the trainees and respective managements). In all, 971 Problem solving and Optimization projects have been completed all India, of which 543 projects are completed in the North.

I am pleased to inform that the 20th Batch of Six Sigma Black Belt Programme of Northern Region will commence from **Monday, 12th April, 2021** from **10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Cisco WebEx Platform.**

Due to the challenging situation that we face currently posed by the pandemic situation, we are planning to have this event on a virtual mode only, keeping in mind the safety of all concerned.

Hence, the duration of this program will be for 20 days which will spread over a period of 7 months. The detailed Calendar (with the dates of the Modules) is enclosed at **Annexure II**, to enable the participants to plan their schedule.

Based on inputs received from the participants and observation of faculty, we have taken the initiative and upgraded the course brochure – the fourth version of the Course material. In our effort to bring-in continuous improvement in the services to our members, a new handout indicating the rules that needs to be followed during Tool application has been developed to guide the participants and will be given to them during the course. **This will be an additional handout to the existing material. Further more, the participants of the 20th batch will get all the material online.**
