We are excited to welcome a large participation from all ACMA members based in Uttarakhand despite the pandemic not allowing us to hold the competition for the past two years now.

To ensure an inclusive growth, a level playing field at the competition has been provided to members from the **SSI Sector** to actively participate and promote QC activities i.e. a separate stream at the competition for **SSI members** to contest amongst each other. **However, this would depend on the number of entries from the SSI member companies**.

In order to motivate the teams further and encourage more participation from the membership, we added more awards since last two years. Accordingly there will be Awards as stated below:

- a) Overall **Best 3 nos.** who wins the **First 3 positions** of this QC Competition
- b) Best Presentations under each category:
 - i. Cost reduction
 - ii. Customer Complaints Reduction.
 - iii. Facility Improvement.
 - iv. Productivity Improvement.
 - v. Safety.

Please follow the Guidelines enclosed while nominating teams.

- Teams with Diploma Holders/ITI / Engineers/Any Technical background will be evaluated upon higher level of tools application and knowledge and will have a different weightage criteria decided by the Jury including Problem Selection, Observations, Analysis, Action, Savings, Checks, Standardization etc. This is to ensure a level playing field for a healthy competition.
- A QC team should not have more than 5 members (1 Facilitator + 4 members).-Any One (1) Technical background Person in the Team will be count under Technical Team
- Additional members in the team will be considered as additional delegates and the participation fee of delegates will be charged.
- The maximum number of QC teams for participation at the competition will be restricted to 30 Companies on a "first-come-first-serve" basis due to time constraint.
- Payment need to be made prior the Competition (Compulsory) through NEFT/Cheque/ ACMA Payment Gateway for payment transfer https://www.acma.in/acma_hdfc/
- Companies with no dues to ACMA like Event Outstanding, Membership Subscription outstanding will only be eligible to participate.
