Minutes of the 1st Meeting of ACMA Executive Committee 2019-20 held on Friday 6th September 2019 at The Taj Palace, New Delhi

The list of members present at the meeting is given at Annexure I.

Mr. Ram Venkataramani, President, ACMA 2018-19 welcomed all Past-Presidents present and the newly elected members to the 1st Meeting of the Executive Committee for the year 2019-20.

He congratulated the members on being elected to the Executive Committee and placed on record his appreciation for the guidance and encouragement by ACMA Past Presidents. He also thanked the EC members for their support during his tenure as President ACMA.

Thereafter, the agenda was taken up for discussion.

1. Confirmation of Minutes

The minutes of the 6th Meeting of the Executive Committee 2018-19 held on 26th July 2019 in Ahmedabad, circulated earlier, were confirmed.

2. Election of President

Mr. Ram Venkataramani proposed the name of Mr. Deepak Jain, Chairman & Managing Director, Lumax Industries Ltd. as the President of ACMA for the year 2019-21. Mr. Deepak Chopra, Group CEO, Anand Group seconded the proposal.

Mr. Deepak Jain was unanimously elected as the President of ACMA for the year 2019-21.
