

9TH REGIONAL KAIZEN COMPETITION

(Virtual) Friday, 10 December 2021

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION

Key Points :

- a) The competition would be organized in WEBEX Digital platform
- b) Time slots would be assigned to each team for participation that would be communicated one day prior to the event, to the participating teams.
- c) Companies have to ensure good internet connectivity on the date of the event for smooth functioning of the competition.
- d) The Team would have to install the required application on its laptop and share the screen for making their presentation, with their camera option on.
- e) The Team would have to necessarily log-in with the Name & Company Name only.
- f) Winners would be announced in an online valedictory session on the 10th December 2021.
- g) In case number of teams exceed, the competition may be extended to one more day and the valedictory would be held on the end of the 2nd day's competition.
- 1. ACMA member Companies with no dues to ACMA will only be eligible to participate
- 2. Only Engineering Kaizen(s) with innovation should be presented.
- 3. The Kaizen proposer-cum-implementer should ideally be an Engineer/ Diploma Holder.
- 4. Case Study can be presented by maximum 3 team members.
- 5. Presentation (material text and delivery) to be made in English language
- 6. Focus should be on Productivity, Quality, Cost, Delivery and Safety.
- 7. Should have used higher level of tools (please avoid using the 6 Sigma Tools).

- 8. Saving in terms of value, process improvements, product, costs (cost in terms of energy, tooling, etc), accidents, etc.
- 9. Presentation should preferably have a video clipping of before and after. Presentation may include photographs also. Presenters may bring models/ small parts as a support for presentation
- 10. Kaizens involving expenditure of huge capital will not be accepted.
- 11. Kaizen presentation in power point, should not be more than 5 minutes and preferably not more than 20 slides.
- 12. There will be a 3 minute Q&A / Viva.
- 13. 2 minutes change-over time would be given after the Q&A.
- 14. Kaizen Sheet & Presentations should be made preferably in the format provided by ACMA for standardization.
- 15. The Kaizen sheets and presentations should reach ACMA not later than, November 30th, 2021.
- 16. The Competition being online, ACMA has to share all the presentations with the Jury prior.
- 17. Juries have decided to give weightage to presentations reaching on time. For presentations reaching after deadline will not be awarded this weightage.
- 18. Scores will not be shared with teams/individuals.
- 19. Jury's decision would be final and cannot be challenged
- 20. All Kaizens received would form part of the hand-out material in appreciation of the efforts put by the Kaizen implementer.
- 21. Kaizen not more than one year old & not presented in any other forum/Contest should be presented.
