Seeking urgent inputs on Regulatory Compliance Burden

The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India is the nodal Department has initiated a study on Ease of Doing Business and Reducing Compliance Burden.
