


# Overview of "Exports" for Indian auto component industry in FY 20




- ➤ Europe, the biggest market, saw a substantial fall in numbers, whereas North America and Asia remained stable in a challenging year for the auto industry.
- ➢ 'Drive Transmission & Steering', alongside 'Engine', remain the 2 dominant segments, accounting for 53% of exports. 'Electricals & Electronics' delivered strong growth, as the EV revolution continues to gather pace.
- The trade deficit in the auto sector declined, in line with other major Indian industries, as auto sales struggled domestically.


# Overview of "Imports" for Indian auto component industry in FY 20



- FY20 saw a marked decrease in auto component imports into India, as slowing domestic sales, protectionist domestic policies and the COVID-19 pandemic reduced domestic demand for foreign components.
- > 'Electricals and Electronics' now comprise 15% of all components imported into India.
- ➤ In a year where imports have fallen greatly, South Korea and Belgium saw double digit growth in products shipped to India
- ➤ The **Asian** market, which saw the smallest decline in FY 20 amongst all regions, now constitutes 65% of auto imports



### Imports - Top Countries (\$ Mn), 2020\*







# 6M-FY 21: Summary of 6M performance y-o-y for "Exports" and "Imports"




- ➤ Europe and North America remain the two primary export destinations, together accounting for ~63% of exports
- The United States remains the largest export market, while German market saw the smallest dip in H1 FY21 (Y-o-Y)




- ➤ Imports have been hit by the COVID-19 lockdown, which has reduced production capacity and retail demand significantly.
- ➤ Asia remains the primary importer; Asian imports declined ~41% Y-o-Y
- Imports from Asia and Europe account for~91% of the market


### 6M-FY 19 vs. 6M-FY 20 vs. 6M-FY 21 Exports


