In a major step to facilitate 'Smart Manufacturing', and impart world class Technical and Behavioural skills to Auto Component Manufacturers, ACMA officially launched its first Centre of Excellence (CoE) named as SAKSHAM - at IIT Delhi, Sonipat campus on 31st July 2018.

ACMA Centre of Excellence (ACoE) - SAKSHAM endeavours to create a sustainable and enabling skill ecosystem via medium of creating world class infrastructure equipped with latest technology of machines and software in its Lab. And this labs are set up for spurring growth & furtherance capacity of auto component makers.

In order to foster skill development across the sector, SAKSHAM collaborated with industry leaders to arrange suitable training modules to ACMA membership & in view of this, ACoE gained support of its Knowledge Partners for providing intellectual guidance and to run collaborative trainings for capacity building of industry.

The role of Knowledge Partners is instrumental in building robust trainings and delivering the same thought leadership and knowledge management.

"Whilst the Centre of Excellence, in the short-term would be used for skilling and capability building, our longterm vision is that the shared resources at the Centre be used by the industry for co-development of products and creating Intellectual Property."

State of Art - Mechatronics Lab

Mechatronics Lab and Design Lab Set-up at a total cost of Rs. 4.5 crore and this lab is focused on imparting skills in the domain of automation and Modular Production Systems (MPS) while the Design lab aims to enable auto component MSMEs for designing and developing new products. 7 Stations Mechatronics Lab is equipped with training equipment for fluidics lab (pneumatics), advance pneumatic training kit, basics and advance electro pneumatic training kit, servo motor drive training system with linear drive and sensor for object detection.

This lab is imparting skills and knowledge on Modular Automation Production Systems ranging from basics of low-cost automation to PLC (Program & Logic Control) to SCADA (Supervisory Control & Data Acquisition) systems. Participants are trained on the Modular Production Systems (MPS) which will give insights into industrial production process. The lab includes work stations for training in Servo Motor Drive Systems, Sensors for "object detection", PLC & Human Machine Interface (HMI), Electro Hydraulic and Basic & Advance electro-pneumatics. It also has a Six-Station MPS, a Robot Station and an Industry 4.0 station.

We are hopeful that the industry will make use of this infrastructure and benefit from this new initiative.











Design Lab - Launch by ACMA President



The Design Lab is Aimed at facilitating the auto component industry, especially Tier-2s and Tier-3s, in designing and developing new products, the Design lab is equipped with 16 high-end Workstations, a 3D Scanner and Design Software. The Dassault 3-D Experience Software, the most advanced and widely used design software includes modules for New Product Development, Tooling Designing and Reverse Engineering.
